A public hearing on the purposed Local Law #2-2008 – Wind Energy Facilities Law was held by the Town of Enfield Town Board Thursday, November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2008 at the Enfield Community Building, 182 Enfield Main Road, Ithaca, New York at 6:30 p.m. with Supervisor Podufalski presiding.
