



Lottie May Eddy Vann was born on June 15, 1877, her parents were Edgar and Mary Jane Hardenburg Eddy of Enfield. She was teacher at Enfield Falls School (located and I found her teaching at Willow Creek School from 1901 to 1903. In February 20, 1907 she married Bertram Irving Vann in Enfield. Their children were Paul (1908); Winifred May (1909) and Philip Sheridan (1913). They lived in the area of Willow Creek in the Town of Ulysses. Lottie died on June 17, 1941.



District #14 (Budd) was located in the front of Budd Cemetery on the south side of Gray Road. The school was closed in 1933 and the pupils were sent to Ithaca. There were not enough pupils to warrant hiring a teacher. The school house was sold and torn down.
