LOCAL LAW NO 3 OF THE YEAR 1998.

A local law Amending Local Law No. 2 of the Year 1998 Extending a Moratorium on Telecommunication Towers

BE IT Enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Enfield as follows:

Section 1. Purpose.

This law is necessary to extend the provision of Local Law No. 2 of the Year 1998 for a period of ninety (90) days from and after the effective date of this law.

Section 2. Amendment.

The ninety (90) day period provided in Local Law No. 2 of the Year 1998 during which no application for the construction or erection of a telecommunications tower or accessory use may be filed, accepted or processed be and hereby is amended to provide for an additional moratorium period of ninety (90) days from and after the effective date of this local law.

Section 3. Validity.

If any sentence, clause or phrase of this law is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this law.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This law shall become effective upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State.
