By October 1975, it seemed time to have a special event to celebrate the accomplishments of the young people in the Summer Day Camp and the After School Programs. The tradition of the annual Enfield Harvest Festival began on October 18, 1975 and so did the quilts. To benefit the Enfield Community Council, there was a raffle of donated items, including a **quilted pillow** by Nina Linton and a live lamb from Jim Linton --both won by a surprised and smiling Helen Jackson! Most of the quilts were started out being sewn by the Enfield Senior Citizens group of Enfield.

This quilting tradition has carried on through out the years. Here are a few of the 1980's quilts.
