Tompkins County has implemented SwiftReach's **Swift911™** alerting system as a shared service with the municipalities within the county.

Swift911™ allows communities to notify their residents of emergency and non-emergency events. Emergency messages may include information on floods, fires, water emergencies, road closures, missing persons, evacuation orders, and weather emergencies. Non-emergency communication notifications may include Township information such as event and program reminders, service information, and other general communications.

Over 1000 published Enfield phone numbers were uploaded into the system at the County level; however, many of our community members are not in the system because they have unlisted, unpublished or cell phone numbers. It is important for residents, employees and business owners to provide and update their contact information to ensure emergency information can be passed on to everyone in a timely matter.

Ways to sign up:

- Directly to the Website: http://tompkinscountyny.gov/doer/swift911ALERTS
- Participants select which alerts they want to subscribe to under the "add subscriptions" tab. They may also "Subscribe" to other areas of interest. Check back often to see if there have been subscriptions added.
- The Town of Enfield participates in Tompkins County's Swift 911 service. The Town
 of Enfield subscription, offers emergency and non-emergency announcements.
- To install the Swift911[™] Mobile App on your mobile device, simply text "Swift911" to "99538".

How will I receive these alerts?

Alerts or notifications from your local agencies will be sent by one or more of the following:

- A voice call to your home and/or mobile numbers
- A text message to your mobile phone
- An email to one or more addresses
- Residents with the Swift911[™] mobile app will receive push notifications.
