ABSTRACT OF LOCAL LAW ENTITLED: "Local Law Number ___ of 2020: A Local Law Providing for the Abolition of the Elected Position of Town Clerk and the Creation of the Appointed Position of Town Clerk of the Town of Enfield", as adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Enfield upon July ___, 2020, to be submitted as PROPOSITION NO. 2 and voted upon in the Town of Enfield at the general election to be held upon November 3, 2020.

Currently, the Town Clerk is elected by residents of the Town who are qualified to vote in Town elections. This local law changes the way the position of Town Clerk is filled. It provides that the Town Board will appoint the Town Clerk, effective January 1, 2022. The local law is subject to the approval of residents of the Town who are qualified to vote. A "yes" vote indicates approval of the change to an appointed Town Clerk, rather than an elected one. A "no" vote indicates disapproval of the change.
