FARM NOTE

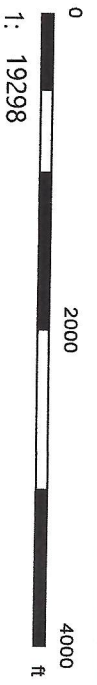
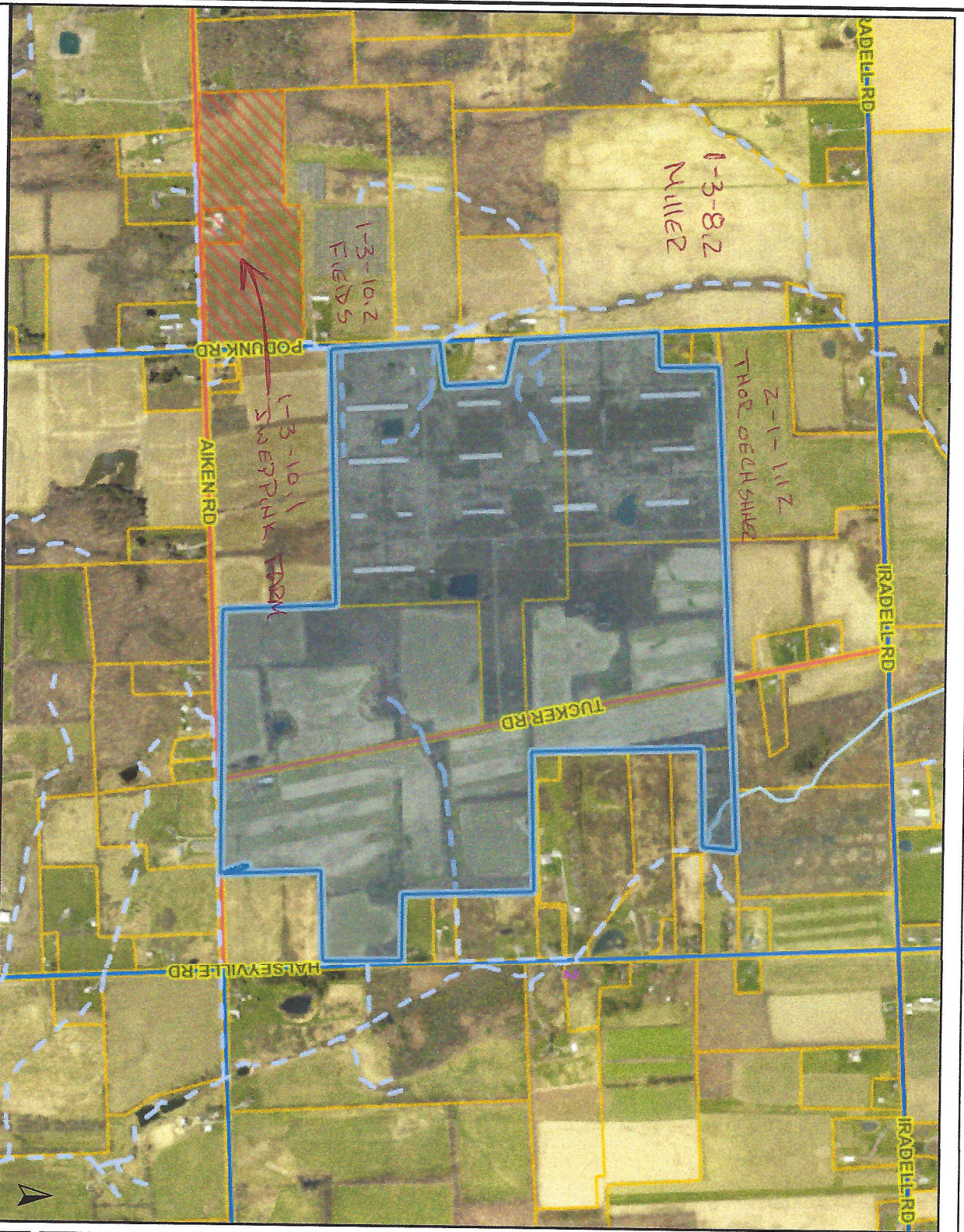

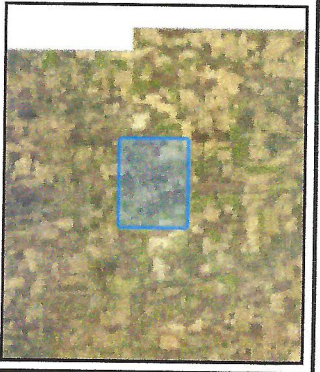


Map Title
