Hi Tom,

It was nice to meet with you and Patrick this morning.

Based on the site visit, it appears there is adequate usable space available at 1703/1707 Mecklenburg Rd to increase the size of the proposed wastewater treatment system from a 4 bedroom system to a 5 system. However, in order to meet setback requirements the size and placement of the proposed structures needs to be carefully planned (the approximate location of the proposed structure on the existing access driveway will likely need to be situated further towards the road) and tree clearing in the southwest corner is likely required to make adequate space for the sand filter.
