ABSTRACT OF LOCAL LAW ENTITLED: "Local Law Number 3 of 2024: LOCAL LAW INCREASING THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE TOWN CLERK FROM TWO (2) to FOUR (4) YEARS", as adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Enfield upon July 10, 2024, to be submitted as PROPOSITION NO. 3 and voted upon in the Town of Enfield at the general election to be held upon November 5, 2024.

Currently, the Town Clerk is elected to a two (2) year term This local law extends the term of the elected office of the Enfield Town Clerk from two (2) to four (4) years. The local law is subject to the approval of residents of the Town who are qualified to vote. A "yes" vote indicates approval of the change to extend the term of the elected office of the Enfield Town Clerk from two (2) to four (4) years. A "no" vote indicates disapproval of the change.
