


Why do we license dogs and what is your license money used for?

Towns are required, by New York State law, to provide dog control and to license dogs. Any dog license fees collected by the Town can only be spent on dog related services. All of your license fee stays in the Town of Enfield and helps pay for the cost of our contract with the SPCA. The State Surcharge, also required by law, is sent to the New York State Animal Population Control Fund and is distributed by grants to non-profit organizations for low cost spay/neuter programs throughout New York State (excluding New York City).

Failure to license your dog could result in a ticket, a court appearance and a fine.

All dogs over four months old must be licensed.



Control of Rabies:

Rabies remains an important health concern. Dog licensing requires rabies vaccinations and ensures that your dog, and your neighbor's, is upto-date and protected. Not only does this protect dogs, but your family, your neighbors and the entire community.

How to License Your Dog

REQUIRED FORMS:

- A <u>valid rabies certificate</u> is required by Public Health Law #2145
- 2. If spayed or neutered, a veterinarian's certificate is required. If you have acquired an older dog and have no records, a veterinarian can examine the animal and sign an affidavit as to whether it was spayed or neutered.
- 3. Any rabies or spay/neuter forms mailed to us will be returned to you.
